What's been happening this week?

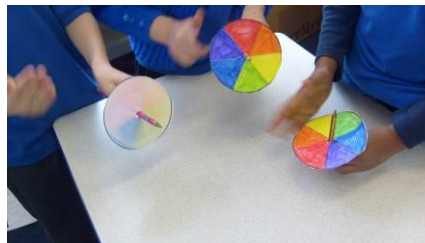


SCIENCE WEEK

We have really enjoyed Science Week and have taken part in lots of exciting activities about light and colour. After discussing the difference between primary and secondary colours, we did a variety of experiments to test how these colours mix, such as 'magic milk', 'colour spinners' and 'cascading colours'.

We learnt that white light is made up of lots of different colours. When we created bubbles, we were able to see these different colours reflected in the bubble skins. We noticed that when we mixed vinegar and bicarbonate of soda, the chemicals reacted and created lots of bubbles. These bubbles were full of a gas called carbon dioxide. We tried this experiment in a sandwich bag and sealed the top to see what would happen. The pressure of the gas inside the bubbles caused the bag to explode with a BANG!

Thank you to all our visitors who have worked with Rosewood class during the week. The children have been inspired by what they have learnt and are keen to do lots more exciting experiments!
