Miss News is leaving at the end of this term. We wish her all the very best for the future and thank her for her dedication and hard work during the past year of teaching at Bourn. Mrs Reed is also leaving, but will be coming into school from time to time to continue with the coordination of Read Write Inc. News of our new teacher appointments and class teachers for next year will be sent out shortly.

We are dedicating next week to the celebration of our 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and the teachers have been busy planning an exciting curriculum to support this. We are starting on Monday morning with a walk to the Church for the Thanksgiving Service. On Wednesday afternoon, following an entertainment for the whole school, each class will hold their own party. On Thursday the BSA have arranged an after-school Summer barbecue, with lots of fun things to do. Finally, on Friday morning, starting at 9.05am, there is a musical concert where each class has prepared a song and dance from a different decade to entertain you. Every child is taking part, so do please come along. This will be very different from the usual Friday assembly and Heidi Allen, our local MP, is our special guest.

The annual reports will be sent out on 6<sup>th</sup> July and consultation opportunities have been arranged for the following week if you would like to meet with the class teacher. More details will be provided in due course.

This is followed by visits to their new schools, the Year 6 Fete, the Leavers' barbecue and, finally, the Leavers' Play on 19<sup>th</sup> July. The term ends on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> July, with a special assembly at 9.00 am and a lunchtime picnic on the field, when parents are invited to join us. As has happened in the past, parents will be able to take their children home following the end of the lunch break at 1.00 pm.
