English

In English this week, we have continued with instructional writing. We have looked at imperatives and adverbs and how these are used to add detail to commands. We also organized an instructional text and annotated it showing the key features such as parentheses, rhetorical questions and technical vocabulary. Children are now beginning to plan their own instructional writing based on controls for a futuristic machine.

Maths

This week in Maths we revised our work on place value and used it to help up multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1000. We have also been developing our formal written methods for addition, particularly focusing on the column method. We worked with a variety of large numbers and decimal numbers and tried to solve 'real-life' problems relating to money and measure. We also solved some missing number problems including decimals.

Science

In Science we have been learning about light, how it travels in straight lines and reflects off objects to enable us to see. We also found out about periscopes, how they work and the use of mirrors involved in reflecting images.

Computing

In our computing lesson this week we looked at Secure Websites and how to identify whether a website is safe and secure to use. We looked at the use of 'https', the padlock symbol, the use of green font, the inclusion of a privacy policy and standard marks to identify websites that are safe to use. We talked about the dangers of sharing personal information and how to keep ourselves safe.
