Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you all agree what a fabulous class assembly it was! The children have impressed me with their willingness to sing, dance and act. We have worked very hard to make it such a magnificent assembly. Well done Rosewood.

English: This week the children have been working on planning and writing their own fable. During the drafting process we have been focusing on writing correctly punctuated dialogue and how to include conjunctions to extend our sentences. We have also been thinking about how we proof read our work and how best to use a dictionary to correct spelling errors.

Maths: The children are becoming more confident now with written methods for addition and subtraction. We have been looking at a compact written method for addition whilst still using counting up (frog) for subtraction. We have also been using our addition skills to check our counting up skills (using the inverse). We finished the week with our mental maths test. The children are finding this tricky, however scores are already improving. We have talked through how to approach the questions and how to listen out for key information.

Other Subjects

In science, the children enjoyed finding out what materials they could add to a circuit that still made the light bulb or motor work. We learnt what a conductor and insulator were. We concluded that metals conduct electricity however we remain puzzled by the fact that our metal chair legs didn't conduct. We plan to investigate further.
