It has been a pleasure to meet with so many of you during parent consultations this week and I look forward to meeting with the rest of you during the forthcoming week.

English: The children have enjoyed learning about the early life of Leonardo da Vinci. We have used this knowledge to tie in with our grammar focus of writing sentences using fronted adverbials. We have ended the week by writing our own imaginary autobiography based on our lives from now until we are 29 years old. Preview of spellings for next week:- division, invasion, confusion, decision, collision, television, revision, erosion, inclusion, explosion.

Maths: The children started the week by doubling and halving two-digit and three-digit numbers. We then moved on to the 4 and 8 times tables and 3 and 6 times tables using our doubling skills to help us. We also learnt the associated division facts. We have been using these skills to help us in our mental maths test this week.

Other Subjects In enrichment we learnt about the Wright brothers and the invention of the first airplane. In Science, the children have been carrying out an investigation to test their understanding of circuits by seeing what happens when we add more bulbs or more batteries. In RE we are looking at how to be a Good Samaritan. We are very much enjoying our art work. Last week we sketched leaves. We developed this further this week by using different coloured paper and pastels.
