This week we have spent a lot of time rehearsing, of course, and the children are doing really well learning the songs and their lines. It is all coming together nicely! We also very much enjoyed the children's speeches this week. We had a huge range of subjects that we all appreciated.

English: The children are at the final stages of their information text about an instrument of their choice. We have looked at what makes a good information text, particularly what will hook the reader in to read our writing. We have continued to work hard on the structure of our sentences and using conjunctions. We have also been making sure that we arrange our writing into paragraphs.

Maths: Our main focus has continued to be multiplication. We began the week by using i-pads to play some multiplication games. We have been using the grid method to multiply 2-digit numbers by 1 digit. Extra practice can be found on the BBC Skillswise page, game-written-multiplication. We have been also been making links with our known multiplication and division facts. We finished the week by using 'chunking' to divide with no remainders.

Other Subjects. We have managed to find time to squeeze in some Science work this week. The children investigated 'what is the best material to muffle a sound'? The children have very much enjoyed time playing hockey in P.E. this term. They have learnt skills including a slap and push pass, Indian dribbling, and how to work as a team.
