English

This week the children have been learning about semi-colons, onomatopoeia words and fronted adverbials in our grammar work.

Continuing with our learning on 'The Highwayman', the children have worked hard to create diary entries as the character of Bess from the poem.

Maths

In Maths, the children have been converting improper fractions to mixed numbers and vice versa. We worked practically with cubes and used visual representations first, before moving onto mental strategies or informal jottings to convert. Once secure with this concept, the children applied their understanding to solving word problems (often involving pizzas or cakes!). We have also been solving word problems involving multiplication, using the column method.

<u>PSHCE</u>

The children have been learning about drugs in PSHCE lessons. We discussed what drugs are and identified drugs that are legal and illegal in our society. Next week we will focus on discussing smoking and will study the laws on smoking and the effects that smoking can have on a person.
