**English:** This week we have started a new unit of work on 'Fairy tales'. We have been focusing on the story of The Princess and the Pea. We retold the story with our partners focusing on our choices of language. We then thought about the conversations the characters would be having and we wrote dialogue thinking carefully about our use of inverted commas. We ended the week by looking at existing fairy tales and giving them a twist.

**Maths:** In Maths, we have been continuing with compact addition using four numbers to accurately add up. We have also been subtracting pairs of three digit numbers using decomposition (carrying). The children have been really enthusiastic about their maths this week and really enjoyed taking on the role of 'teacher' to explain how they completed the sum.

**Other Subjects.** We began the week by having Sara from the Oral Care Team come and talk to us about how to look after our teeth. The children then reflected upon these messages to design a poster. We have continued our learning about the Rainforest by learning about its different layers and what lives in them. We also enjoyed our music this week and got to perform our raps that we have been working on.
