English:

This week we have been concentrating on practicing and performing our plays for our assembly. We have been thinking about how to deliver our lines and act out the stage directions.

Maths:

In Maths, we have been concentrating on methods for multiplying three digit numbers by single digit numbers moving from using the grid method to a vertical layout. We are also continuing to work hard on our multiplication facts. I have introduced the children to a new test against the clock. We began with our 2, 5 & 10 times table facts.

Most of our time this week has been focused on our class assembly. In our climate work, we have continued to monitor our weather instruments.
