### English

In English, the children have continued to learn about explanation texts. They have been looking at imaginary inventions such as the squabble shield, the doggy umbrella and rocket boots and in turn have writing imaginary explanations of how they work.

### Maths

In Maths, the children have begun their decimal unit by learning about tenths and hundredths. They practised using visual representations, place value charts and number lines as ways to express decimal numbers and found equivalent decimals and fractions for tenths and hundredths.
