English

In English, the children have continued to learn skills in effectively writing a setting description. We spent the beginning of the week revising figurative language and finding lots of examples in 'Why the Whales Came'. With lots of skills and tips in place, the children then wrote their own setting description of the Birdman's Cottage on the island of Bryher.

Maths

In Maths, the children have been learning to round decimal numbers to whole numbers or to numbers with one or two decimal places. We have also been using protractors to measure acute and obtuse angles.

Enrichment
