English

In English this week, we have revised some grammatical terminology and practised identifying verb tenses and word class. We have also revised words, which can be used as prepositions and conjunctions. The children have also completed reading comprehensions and put into practice the skills we learnt last week about how to explain opinions using evidence from the text. Children have also completed their free writing on the subject of the Titanic. We have some excellent narrative stories, diary entries and poetry.

Maths

In Maths this week, children have revised their arithmetic and reasoning skills. We have looked at a range of different subjects and revised some key vocabulary like factors, multiples, prime numbers etc. Children have also had some practice at completing past papers and we have used these to revise areas which proved challenging.
