English:

We are still enjoying 'The Butterfly Lion' by Michael Morpurgo. This week we have been thinking about the experiences that the central character Bertie had when he was in the trenches during World War 1. We wrote a letter to his friend Millie recounting his time there. We were particularly focusing on our use of verbs and adverbs and how to be a constructive friend during the editing process.

Maths:

In Maths, we have been concentrating on decimals. We have been developing our understanding of place value, particularly tenths and hundredths. We have also been adding **decimals and comparing their values**. It's great to see the children so enthusiastic about using 'Time Table Rock Stars' to help with their multiplication facts. Use of these interactive games is homework for all due to the imminent multiplication assessment and Rock Stars is a fun way in which to practise these skills.

Assembly:

On Wednesday morning, the children had an assembly from local Channel Swimmer Ed Williams from Elite Swimming Academy. The children learnt all about Ed's extreme swims all over the world including the English Channel, Irish Channel and Gibraltar Strait.
