In English this week we have started a new unit of work, persuasive writing. Our focus is on zoos. The children have been having discussions about what is good and bad about zoos. In addition to this, we are continuing to think about how to punctuate direct speech and how to use the present perfect form of verbs in the past tense.

Maths

The children will be sitting the tables test very shortly so any practice of multiplication facts against the pressure of time would be most beneficial.
