The children have been working very hard in Class Acorn. They have amazed me with the progress they have made with their writing. This week they have particularly enjoyed writing activities linked to their role play. They have been writing down patient's details in the role play Doctor's surgery and marking children's work in the role play School. Have a lovely weekend!

Mathematics

This week in mathematics we have been focusing on addition. The children have been adding up the spots on both sides of a domino and writing number sentences to show their workings out. In 'Planning to Play' the children practised their addition skills using various objects and wrote their number sentences on whiteboards.

The children have also been practising number formation. We have been focusing on 'teen' numbers and making sure the numeral is written correctly.

Literacy

In literacy this week the children have been writing out patient details in the role play Doctor's surgery. We pretend Barney Bear was poorly and recorded his symptoms and how they needed to be treated. The children wrote in sentences and tried hard to sound out their words. Once they had finished their writing they enjoyed dressing up as Doctors and using all the equipment to help Barney feel better.

The children had a great time taking part in the charity games on Tuesday afternoon. All the games had been designed and made by the Year 6s. They had put lots of effort and imagination into the games and the Acorn children thoroughly enjoyed playing them.
