CEDAR'S WEEK

LITERACY

The children have continued practising their skills associated with instruction writing this week. I have been very pleased with the standard of work they are producing. It is interesting for the children to see how easy it can be to understand and interpret a set of instructions but how tricky it can be to write a detailed explanation of the steps involved.

In Numeracy this week we have revisited 2D and 3D shapes and have looked at symmetry. The highlight, I think the children will agree, was creating 3D shapes out of play-doh!
