



What have we been doing in Cherry this week?

This week, there has been a real focus on developing good relationships between the children. Our class discussions are having a really positive influence on many of the children, especially during break times.

Literacy This week the year 5 children have been deconstructing fables and identifying the counterpoints used in them to illustrate human folly, such as the use of fierce and passive animal characters, or clever and foolish ones. They then planned and wrote their own fables based on the features they have learned. The year 6 children have been developing their reading and grammar skills, looking at subordinate clauses, infinitives and prefixes.

Maths. The year 6 children have practised past maths papers, identifying how to interpret different types of questions accurately to maximize success! They also have revisited and consolidated skills from feedback. The year 5 children have been working on units of measure, converting capacity and length, and carrying out some practical and word problem solving involving measure.

Other Subjects: The year 5 children have had lots of PSHE on 'Getting on and Falling Out' which has involved learning how to develop their social skills in order deal with friendship issues appropriately and positively. This has involved lots of team work, games and discussion.

In the enrichment curriculum, the children have been learning about crime and punishment pirate style! They have learned about the different gruesome methods employed, and devised some imaginative ones of their own. They also created their own Pirate Code of Conduct based on research of real ones from the 18th Century.

What will we be doing in Cherry next week?

The children will learn about some different aspects of crime and punishment in the enrichment curriculum. In art, they will be continue to create their wonderful pieces of art for our sea themed project. Science will be linked to our sea theme, involving forces and boats.

In RE the children will be learning how Christians see Jesus, based on his teachings and
