English

The children have been continuing with a short unit of work on biographies this week. We learned how to structure a biography and then apply appropriate punctuation conventions such as bullet points and subheadings to separate the text. We also used more sophisticated time connectives to link the sentences together. Finally, the children wrote their own biography on Roald Dahl with whom they are all very familiar.

Maths

In our maths lessons we have just finished our topic on fractions that the children began last week. We have explored how to add together fractions with the same denominator as well as adding together fractions with different denominators. The children have worked together to deepen their understanding of fractions using the various equipment we have in school.

Art

This week, the children learned about Egyptian Gods which linked with our Enrichment topic of Ancient Egypt. We discussed who the Gods were and their role in Egyptian society. The children realised that there are many Gods in the Egyptian religion and soon became very familiar with their roles. To deepen our knowledge, the children designed an Egyptian God onto papyrus paper and then used paints in the Egyptian colours to make this stand out. We were all very proud of our work that we decided to turn this into a book of the dead to display within our classroom.
