English

This week in English the children have been reading a number of poems on the theme of the sea, and have been identifying features such as simile, metaphor, alliteration, onomatopoeia and personification. They have also written a short poem of their own, modelled on one that they have read. They are also looking at expanding simple sentences to form evocative writing.

Maths

In Maths the children have been learning to recognise acute, obtuse and reflex angles. They have practised estimating angles, measuring and drawing angles accurately using a protractor. In addition they have been using their knowledge about angles on a straight line adding up to 180 degrees to find missing angles.

Science

The class has continued to learn about the Earth's rotation on its axis and why we have day and night. The children have also learned about the Earth's movement relative to the Sun and how its tilt affects the length of day and night at different times of the year - for example why the Sun never sets on the North Pole in summer, and what it is like to live in the world's most northerly city in winter, when it is dark for almost 22 hours a day. They have also learned about the Moon's phases and its movement relative to the Earth.
