English

This term we are returning to the narrative form. We will be using David Wiesner's award winning book 'Tuesday' as a stimulus for the children's writing. It is a beautifully illustrated story with virtually no printed words, but we have no doubt that the children will come up with their own descriptive language. Maths

This week we have been revising the following: number bonds, place value, mental methods for addition and subtraction and addition and subtraction using the making ten method. Next week we will be going on to looking at different strategies for adding two, two digit numbers and how to select the most efficient methods.

Science

This week we started our new science topic 'Animals including humans', Children learned about the key stages and order of the human life cycle and what they have been able to do at different stages of their lives so far, Next week we will be looking at other animal life cycles.
