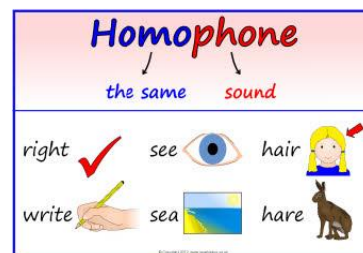
Homework
