## Literacy

- In Literacy this week we enjoyed sharing our holiday news and the children worked hard to write their news in their diaries, including interesting information about their holidays.
- Your child has had a reading book sent home with them this week. Please try and read with your child every day and write in the reading record book when your child requires a new book. Reading records will be monitored regularly by the class teacher.
- Spellings will be given out on a Monday and tested on the following Monday. Children will receive their first set of spellings on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> September and will be tested on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> September. Please practise on rough paper as the spelling books are used for the school test.

## Numeracy

In our Numeracy work this week we have introduced the children to lots of fun mental maths games to practise their counting skills.

All the children completed a number booklet to test their number skills, finding missing numbers, finishing patterns, finding properties of numbers and ordering 1, 2 and 3-digit numbers. We will be continuing to build upon this in our Numeracy work next week.
