Curriculum News

English

We have been using our Minibeast research as an opportunity for non-fiction writing, using the present tense, third person and formal language.

Our grammar focus this week has been on the difference between 'are and 'our' as well as on using an apostrophe for contracted verbs e.g. 'do not' becomes 'don't'. The children usually use these contracted forms correctly in their speech, but sometimes find it hard to remember the spelling in their writing.

Maths

We have been looking at word problems. The children have been given questions in different contexts such as time, length, money and weight and have been using their knowledge of number and calculation to solve them.

Science

We have started our new science topic, Living Things and their Habitats. Children have been learning about the life processes of all living things - plants and animals. They have been identifying things that are living and dead and also thinking about things that have never lived.

Homework

This week as part of our study of the silk worm and the silk moth, we would like children to find out about the differences between moths and butterflies. Do come and collect a sheet if you have not found one in your child's book bag.

Enrichment Curriculum

Class Hazel have been finding out about silk worms this week. We have had a first look at our silk worm eggs which have arrived and will hopefully hatch in a week or so. They are an ideal minibeast to observe, as they have such a short life cycle (6-8 weeks). We have learned all about the history and process of silk making, which originated in China and have studied and painted the symmetry on a silk moth's wings.
