This week pupils in Class Hazel have been exploring addition and subtraction. They started by studying and practising their rapid recall of number bonds to 10, 20 and 100. We then moved on to adding single digit numbers to 2-digit numbers, using a variety of methods.

In writing we have been focusing on the structure of a story, looking at how to carefully craft a good quality beginning, middle and end.

We have also written a recount of our trip to Mountfitchet Castle. Our grammar focus this week has been on verbs and adverbs.
