Curriculum News 5 10

English

Following on from last week's research, Hazel Class have been compiling a comprehensive instruction manual on 'How to hatch an egg'. We have been revisiting different sentence types and incorporating adverbs to provide more detailed instructions.

Maths

We have been revising our calculation skills and visiting areas less familiar with the children, such as working out simple equations such as these:

Are these correct?

$$12 + 4 = 4 + 12$$

$$12 - 4 = 4 - 12$$

$$12 \times 4 = 4 \times 12$$

$$12 \div 4 = 4 \div 12$$

Science

This week the children have learned that plants and animals live in particular habitats which serve their needs. We have studied a range of habitats from around the world and studied the type of organisms living there. Using our knowledge of life processes, we have understood why certain organisms will not survive in other habitats - such as a fish in the desert!



Homework

As the children will be completing their SATs papers next week, no homework or spellings has been set this week.

In preparation for SATs, please ensure children are in school on time and have had a good night's sleep. We will keep the tests as 'low-key' as we can, to minimise any stress for the children.
