Curriculum News

English

Hazel pupils have impressed us this week with their research skills. They used books about space to research facts about the planets and then recorded them in note form and then finally wrote a chapter in their Space Books. Next week we will be researching and writing about a different aspect of Space.

In grammar we focussed on the difference between present and past tense.

Maths

This week in maths we have been looking at different methods for taking away a single digit number from a two digit number. We have looked at the 'getting to ten' method using resources such as multilink and twenty boards, as well as how to use number lines and bead strings. All of the children have worked very hard.

Homework

This week we are focussing on learning to spell the Read Write Inc 'Red' words, which children often misspell in their writing, as they do not follow standard phonetic patterns. Extra spelling lists are available in the classroom if you do not have one.
