Our Literacy work this week focussed on the book 'Ask Dr K Fisher... about minibeasts' by Claire Llewellyn. Dr K Fisher is an 'agony uncle' who is called upon for advice from a range of minibeasts suffering from embarrassing problems - a glow worm that just can't stop blushing, a stick insect who can't find his brother and a ladybird with a spotty problem. The children planned and wrote some amazing letters of their own, stepping into the shoes of a minibeast with a problem and then in turn Dr K Fisher offering words of wisdom.
