We have been ordering and comparing numbers in Maths this week, using our place value knowledge and the 'less than', 'more than' and 'equals' signs. You might want to find and watch the Number Gators clip on YouTube, which helps the children remember the symbols! We then applied all of our Place Value learning by tackling various maths problems and challenges.

Using our Teatime in Space book in English, the children have produced story mountains to help them plan their own version of the story.

They have used this to help structure and sequence their story writing. Hazel Class have created some very imaginative aliens!

We have made a start on our science topic for the term, 'Everyday Materials and their Properties'. As Material Detectives, the children have been identifying different materials around the school and considered the reasons why the material was the most appropriate for its use.
