Curriculum News



5 10

English

This week our grammar focus is on the different sentence functions - commands, statements, questions and exclamations. The children will be thinking about and using these different sentence types, when writing about 'Life in Space'; the third chapter of their Space Book.

Maths

This week we have been continuing our learning on inverse operations for addition and subtraction. We have been looking at how to use the Chinese bars to help us to rearrange number sentences to solve missing number problems. For example: $2 + ? = 7$ so the children have to re-arrange the sentence to $7 - 2 = 5$, to find the missing number. Some children have been extending their learning by using algebra.

Science

This week the children were very excited to taste space food, including space ice-cream and space strawberries as eaten by astronauts when in space! The children discussed the key elements of a balanced diet and learned how foods have to be freeze-dried to enable long-term storage during space missions.

Homework

The focus this week is on grammar and sentence function. Please look out for the sheet which was given out on Thursday. We have been very impressed with the children's homework - thank you very much for your support with this.
