English

In English this week, the children have been writing about the Ancient Maya. They have researched the eating habits of this civilization and their methods of growing and preparing food. The children have drafted out their information texts. They also had the opportunity to make a version of Mayan hot chocolate using cinnamon and chilli powder! They then wrote recipe instructions to add to their information texts. The Mayans chocolate drink was frothy and quite bitter ... we added whipped cream to make ours more delicious!

Maths

In Maths, the children have continued solving the Murder Mystery Maths puzzles – involving problems using semaphore, angles, percentages, calendar dates and braille! They also completed a Maths codebreaker puzzle where they had to decipher a number and letter code.
