What have we been doing in Cherry and Maple this week?

YEAR 6 PUPILS WENT ON THEIR 5 DAY RESIDENTIAL TRIP TO KINGSWOOD.

Literacy This week the Year 5 pupils have enjoyed exploring the fantasy world of 'Myst'. We used a computer animation programme to describe scenery and action. Adjectives, adverbs, metaphors and similes were used to create imaginative descriptive sentences. Many pupils were eager to share their work by providing 'running commentaries' as the animation played on the screen.

Maths Number methods were the focus of maths lessons this week. Addition and subtraction skills were consolidated using formal column methods. These included working with 5 digit numbers as well as solving word problems. The inverse method enabled pupils to check their answers to ensure they were correct, as well as checking with a calculator.

Other Subjects The Year 5 pupils led the French café on Thursday. They created menus in French, designed French flag hats and also practised their conversational skills to ensure they would be able to ask and take their customers' orders. Swimming was enjoyed on Monday and Wednesday and some pupils participated in the swimming gala on Thursday afternoon.

What will we be doing in Cherry and Maple next week?

Next week the Year 5 pupils will perform in the wonderful Opera project at West Road Concert Hall. There is an afternoon rehearsal followed by the evening performance on Wednesday. All pupils will have Moving On morning on Thursday in their new classes when the Year 6s have their new intake day. On Friday the Year 6 pupils will be participating in the athletics festival at CVC. On Tuesday all pupils will be involved in an exciting Olympic themed day led by members of the local churches. This will take place in school - children will need to wear sports shoes.
