From the Head Teacher

I hope that you had a very enjoyable half term break. As this is the shortest term of the School year, we have only five weeks until we break up for the Easter holiday!

Thank you to everyone who responded to the parent survey (70% of parents). We are extremely pleased with the very positive response and a summary will be placed on our website very shortly. We are grateful for your comments and will be acting upon many of your suggestions to further improve the quality of provision at Bourn Primary.

For a number of years Assembly has taken place at 10.15am between Monday and Thursday. However, from next week onwards we are changing the routine of the School morning in order to make more efficient use of time. From Monday, 2nd March Assembly will take place first thing in the morning at 9.00 am. This will run as a trial until the end of the term, when we will evaluate the changes.

During the half term break the doors at the entrance to the lower corridor have been replaced, together with those to the kitchen. We are planning to replace the doors to the main hall in due course.

The Bourn School Association (BSA) Annual General Meeting will take place on Friday, 20th March, straight after the Friday Assembly which will be led by Class Acorn.
