This has been a very busy week indeed with organizing and rehearsing our class assembly. I am sure you'll agree that everyone's efforts really paid off.

English: By 'workshopping' ideas for our class assembly the children came up with some ideas which they developed into sketches. They wanted to link many of the topics they have learned during their time in Rosewood. Together we put them into a script and worked on developing the sketches more fully during rehearsals. All of the children contributed ideas at some level, and all of them were extremely enthusiastic about their class assembly as a result. We hope you enjoyed the outcome, as much as we enjoyed the process!

Maths: Building on our previous week's work involving bar modelling, the children have been learning how to represent maths problems using the bars. This is quite tricky but when they are constructed, they reveal the operation and calculation required in a very visual way. We also practised column methods for all four operations before applying all of these tools to solve actual word problems. Solving the word problems and selecting the most efficient and appropriate method for calculating revealed once again the importance of knowing number facts including times tables.

Other Subjects In PSHE at the end of last week, we held a mock election which went really well. The children formed their own political parties and developed manifestoes reflecting their policies on lunch times, homework, lessons and PE. This promoted lots of discussion, and the party leaders held a question time session for the 'public'. In Science, the children revised the different types of teeth and have devised an experiment to test the effects of liquids on teeth.
