Dear Parents/Carers,

It was lovely to meet some of you during our Essential Guide the Year evening. I hope you found it informative and useful.

English: The children have concentrated on the structure of non-chronological texts. We have been looking at our information is grouped by theme into paragraphs, and how to introduce each paragraph with lead-in sentences. In Grammar, we are revisiting the use of commas to separate items in a list, including nouns and adjectives in preparation for more advanced skills in using commas to separate clauses.

Maths: Place value has continued as our focus this week, with all children comfortably reading and writing 5 digit numbers. The children have been familiarizing themselves with how our decimal system works, exploring the values of each place and the relationship between them. They have used this knowledge to successfully mentally add and subtract in multiples of 10, 100 and 1000 from 5 digit numbers. Our work this week will have prepared them for formal written calculation methods.

Other Subjects In Art we have been learning about L.S. Lowry's city landscapes and his use of limited palettes. The children have created some beautiful pictures of buildings, making and mixing their own colours using just red, yellow and black and white. In science, the children created their own animal, applying the appropriate features to show how they have adapted to their habitat. In PSHE we are learning how to relate to one another in class, being respectful and expressing our own needs effectively.

What will we be doing in Rosewood next week?

We shall be learning about food chains in science. In English we shall be beginning a new narrative unit of work based on a well-known story character and in topic we will be learning about some new inventions!
