### LITERACY

This week's Literacy lessons have seen the culmination of our 'Stories with Familiar Settings' unit. We looked back over everything we have been learning, thinking carefully about how we describe a story setting in detail. We then reviewed our plans for our stories, focusing on our settings. Next we started to write our stories, working on them one step at a time to create thorough beginnings, middles and endings. We learned about the features of each stage and carefully developed our characters and plots while still remembering to describe our settings with exciting vocabulary.

Once our stories are completed, we are hoping to share them with the children in Willow and Hazel classes as we have written them for a younger audience.

### NUMERACY

In Numeracy this week we have been learning about data handling. We thought about the best way to gather information about our class and decided to use a tally chart. We then tallied the initial letters of everyone in Rosewood class and discovered that 'E' was the most frequent. Next we thought about how we could create accurate bar charts to show this data. We also learned about dual bar charts and how it would be useful to use one of these if we wanted to separate boys and girls.

### TOPIC

In Topic, we continued to develop our ideas for a new settlement, adding to our maps and learning about different amenities.



### HOMEWORK

**NUMERACY:** Children had to use a given set of data to create bar charts.
