Dear Parents/Carers,

I have been very impressed with the children's magnificent singing in our Christmas production rehearsals. They sound truly wonderful. Everyone has learned their lines and directions very quickly indeed, and now all we need to do is ensure we know every lyric!

English: While some children have needed extra time to complete their Roman Army non - chronological reports this week, everyone else has been enjoying the freedom of choosing their own topic to research and write about. The children are making excellent use of our new library area to find information books, and are putting into practice their newly acquired note - taking skills. I hope to collate all of the children's topic reports into a class book.

Maths: This week, our focus has been on identifying and using associated number facts involving multiplication and division. We have also applied knowledge of place value and powers of ten for much larger numbers in associated number facts. This is an important step before we move onto multiplication and division methods over the next couple of weeks. Times tables practice is essential at home (as well as in school) and will enable children to approach number problems and calculations confidently.

Other Subjects In RE the children have explored the different ways in which Churches and church spaces are used by people. We have begun our new topic: Sound, in science for which we will need junk modelling equipment please (empty jars, plastic and cardboard containers etc. thank you). In our Enrichment curriculum, we have looked at how the Roman Army built the network of ancient roads across Britain. Next week, we shall be learning about Roman buildings.

What will we be doing in Rosewood next week?

We will continue with our singing and acting rehearsals, putting together all the scenes including the other KS2 classes. Costume letters will be sent out very shortly, but please contact me if there is a problem with obtaining a costume, or if you have any items that other characters may borrow.
