## LITERACY

This week in Literacy, we continued our quest myth stories, describing the challenges our hero characters face and how they overcome them. We now need to write the story endings, creating resolutions to the original problem that led to the characters' quests.

## MATHS

In Maths this week we have been learning more about measure. To start the week, we used our trundle wheels to measure different parts of the nature reserve. We then tried to draw maps of the area, creating an appropriate scale. Next we learned about capacity and estimated how much liquid a variety of containers might hold. We then undertook a challenge to make containers that would hold as much water as our water bottles using just paper!

Finally, we learned about area and how to calculate the area of a square or a rectangle. We were then presented with a bird's eye view map of our classroom and we had to work out the area of the floor using everything we had just learned.

## SCIENCE

This week in Science we completed and presented our PowerPoint presentations about how plants grow using the laptop computers. As well as showing our Science knowledge, we displayed our computer skills, adding animation and sound effects to our slides.
