Following our class performance, our attention has now turned towards identifying the features of play scripts in order to become playwrights at a later stage. We have also looked at homophones - words that sound the same but have different spellings and meanings - to help us make the correct word choice in our writing. We had fun discovering what it would mean if we muddled them up, such as I dyed my hair; My hair died!

## Maths

In Maths we have been using our knowledge and understanding of place value to double, half, add and subtract numbers. We also learned how to round numbers to the nearest 10 or 100 in order to make an estimate answer
