English

At the beginning of the week we started a new unit of work on non-chronological reports. We started off by attempting to create our own reports about woolly mammoths, thinking back to what we have learned about non-chronological reports in the past. We then looked at some examples and worked together to identify their key features. At the end of the unit we will each write a full non-chronological report and compare it to those we wrote about woolly mammoths.

Maths

This week in Maths we have been learning more about shape and space, focusing on coordinates, predominantly in the first two quadrants. We reminded ourselves how to read and write coordinates and how to identify the x and y axes. Next we plotted coordinates to create 2D shapes before finally learning how to translate a shape on a grid.

Science

In Science this week, we found out that our new unit of work is going to be all about 'Animals Including Humans' and we created a title page in our books to show what we know already. We will add to these over the coming weeks as our knowledge grows.
