English

In English this week, the children have been focusing on letter writing. They all received two letters on their desk. Once they had read them, they were able to identify that one of them was formal and the other, informal. The children then used the evidence from the letters to identify key differences between the registers. In other lessons, we have been reading through our scripts and practising our expression and intonation.

Maths

This week in Maths, we have revised our formal calculations for long multiplication and division. The children solved some missing number problems and spotted mistakes in calculations. They designed 'top tips' to avoid errors in their work and then completed some tricky calculations using the formal written methods.

Transition

This week, Class Maple received a visit from the Year 7 team from Comberton. They shared information about our taster morning and who would be able to help them if they had any problems. They spoke about expectations, uniforms and daily routines. Children also had the opportunity to ask questions and they were given a little information leaflet, which children should take with them on their taster morning.

This week the children were very excited to find out the title of the leavers' play: "Robin Hood and the Sherwood Hoodies". They enjoyed getting familiar with the comedic script and starting to learn some of the songs.
