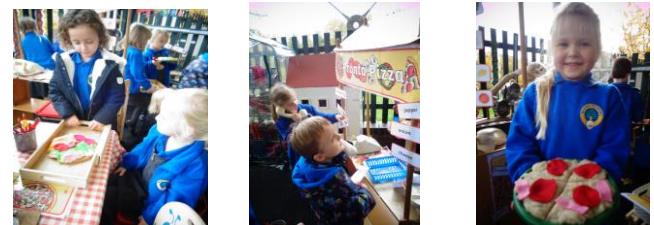
Acorn
