This morning during Community Assembly several of the children enjoyed sharing poetry they had learned at home. It was wonderful to hear such a range of poems and to see the children's confidence in reciting them.

English

In English this week we have been learning about determiners. To start the week we focused on the definite article, (the) and the indefinite article, (a/an). We then found out about the other types of determiners: demonstrative, interrogative, possessive and quantifying and practised identifying them in a range of texts.

Maths

This week in Maths we have learned about measures. First we thought about measures of mass and capacity and revised how we convert grams into kilograms and millilitres into litres. Next we investigated measures of length and distance, thinking about both the metric and imperial systems. We also looked at conversion graphs and to change one unit into another. We looked at several examples and solved some multiple choice questions reading from conversion graphs. Finally we began to draw our own conversion graphs using given measures.

R.E.

In R.E. we are learning about preparations and advent. We considered Christians' views about the Messiah and then prepared an assembly about advent which we will perform on Friday 1st December.

Science

In Science this week we learned about the essential elements of a healthy lifestyle. We already knew about the importance of lots of exercise and a balanced diet and we built on that knowledge to find out the specific benefits of exercise and different food groups to different parts of our bodies.
