Curriculum News

In English this week the children have been learning how to use the conjunction 'and'. They have written 'sandwich sentences' to help them to do this. The children write a sentence (the bread), then they write the conjunction 'and' (the ham) and then they write another sentence on bread to put on top of the ham! They had lots of fun writing sandwich sentences and came up with some very inventive ideas. In maths this week we have started to look at subtraction. We thought about subtraction stories, read subtraction calculations and then solved the calculations using counters to help. In computing we recapped how to log on by using Ctrl + Alt + Del and we started our planet powerpoints. The children know how to add a new slide to their presentations and how to put a title on each slide. Next week we will look at copying and pasting an image from the internet. Our new topic in science is Materials. On Tuesday we went on a materials hunt around the classroom looking for things made from plastic, wood, metal and glass!
