## Curriculum News 5 10

### English

This week have been looking at alternative versions of traditional tales. The children have thought about the story of Little Red Riding Hood and changed elements of it so that they can write their own alternative version. We have looked at how to use speech marks.

### Maths

We have continued with our multiplication theme, exploring arrays in many different ways and applying our new multiplication skills in real-life contexts of problem solving.

### Spellings

These will be tested next Thursday. The focus is on contractions - words formed with an apostrophe, in place of missing letters.
