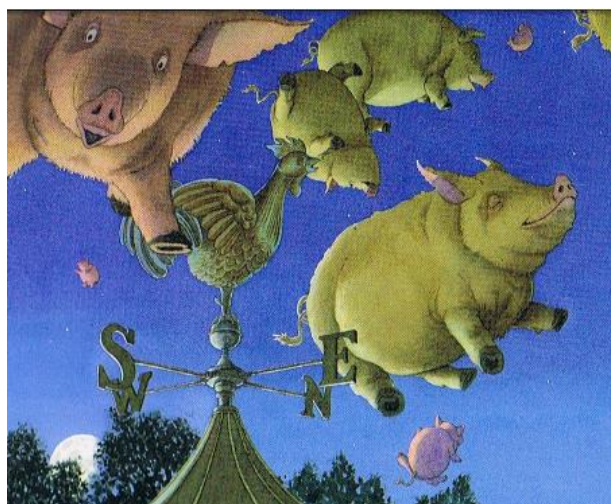

English

Maths

This week we have been honing our mental maths skills - practising mentally adding and subtracting, using doubles and halves to 20 and using our understanding of addition and subtraction to solve inverse problems.

For example if we know that:

$$28 + 10 = 38.$$

Then we can work out:

$$\underline{\quad} + 28 = 38$$

$$38 - \underline{\quad} = 10$$

$$\underline{\quad} - 10 = 28$$
