Curriculum News 5 10

Maths

Children have been developing their understanding of how to describe Position and Direction, using language such as clockwise, anti-clockwise, turn, right, left, up, down.

English

We have been reciting and learning poems - those with repeating patterns such as London's Burning and also more traditional poems such as the Owl and the Pussycat. The children also had an opportunity to write their own poem with repeating patterns.
