Maths

This week in Maths the children were set a transition project by a visiting secondary teacher. The children worked through various open-ended problems demonstrating their knowledge of mathematical vocabulary and calculations using magic squares. They have been set some to complete independently and can use negative numbers, decimals and fractions.

English

In English this week, the children have revised persuasive techniques to create their advertisements for their products and services for the Y6 fete. Children have been using the laptops in order to use a variety of fonts and graphics to make their posters even more eye-catching. In English this week we have also started rehearsals for our end of year production, 'The Adventures of Super Stan!' The children have been set the task of learning all their lines and lyrics as quickly as possible so that we can focus on stage directions and our wonderful acting skills!

Art

Our Art lesson this week was linked to our Mayan Enrichment topic. We learnt about how the Mayans were keen weavers and how they wove items by hand. They used lots of different colours made from natural dyes and fabrics such as cotton, wool and silk. Nowadays, Mayans use chemical dyes and synthetic materials as they are less time-consuming and less expensive. Mayan patterns are often repetitive, symmetrical and geometric. The children used their new knowledge to create Mayan patterns on isometric, squared, spiral and hexagonal paper. They look fantastic!
