Curriculum News

This week we have focused on place value in Maths: placing 2-digit numbers and 3-digit numbers on number lines. In English, we have started our unit on stories by the same author reading 'I'll take you to Mrs Coles' by Michael Foreman and learning how to write descriptively. In Science, we have begun exploring our new topic on light and shadows: discussing what we know about light and different light sources. In art, we have started experimenting with colour, pattern and texture by creating collages of ourselves using different materials and accessories to create colourful and imaginative outfits and clothing. They have made a beautiful decorative display in our classroom!
