In English this week, we have continued our work on instructional writing. We have established the differences required when giving verbal and written instructions as well as revising the key features of this genre. We then had two different instructional texts and used them to find examples of the different written features. This week, we have also completed a short grammar test and revised our knowledge of modal verbs and adverbials.

Maths

This week in Maths we continued to develop our use of place value to multiply and divide numbers by 10, 100 and 1000. We used the less than and greater than symbols to compare numbers up to 10,000,000 and we also practised our arithmetic skills. We are getting used to the variety of questions and working to a time limit.
