English:

We have been focusing on Fables this week. We started the task with a 'cold write'. We then spent some time reading some fables and acting them out. We then revised the rules for writing speech and wrote our dialogue.

Maths:

We started the week by applying our knowledge of 4-digit numbers to some word problems. We found this quite challenging but we persevered and enjoyed succeeding. We then added and subtracted pairs of 2-digit numbers and 2 digit numbers to 3-digit numbers.

We had to think about how to make our car the best it could be by thinking about things such as the size of the wheels and the shape of the bodywork.
